

Revelation's Time of the End

Text Guide #5

- Acts 17:31** God has appointed a judgment day.
- 2 Cor. 5:10** Everyone must appear before the judgment seat of God.
- Rev. 14:7** Before Jesus returns, the hour of His judgment will begin.
- Ex. 25:8** God had Moses make a sanctuary patterned after the one in heaven.
- Heb. 8:1-5** As priests worked in the earthly sanctuary, Jesus, as High Priest, ministers in the heavenly sanctuary.
- Heb. 9:1-7** The priests ministered daily in the holy place. The high priest ministered in the Most Holy place once a year, to cleanse the sanctuary. This was the 'Day of Atonement', or judgment day.
- Dan. 8:14** God tells Daniel when the heavenly sanctuary would be cleansed—at the end of the 2300 days.
- Ezk. 4:6; Num. 14:24** An important prophetic key. In prophecy, a day represents a year. Therefore, the 2300 days of Daniel 8:14 represent 2300 years.
- Dan. 8:17** The prophecy concerning heaven's judgment is for the 'time of the end'.
- Dan. 9:25** The starting date for the prophecy is when "the commandment to restore and rebuild Jerusalem" goes forth. This was 457 BC. (Ezra 7:25).
- Dan. 9:22-24** 70 weeks (490 years) were "determined" (cut off) for the Jews.
- Dan. 9:25** 69 weeks (483 years) would reach to Messiah. 483 years from 457 BC bring us to AD 27, the year Jesus was baptized and announced as Messiah.
- Dan. 9:27** Jesus confirmed the covenant with the Jews for one week (7 years). In the midst of the week (after 3 1/2 years), He would cause the sacrificial system to end. When He died, the temple veil was torn, and the sacrifices ended.
- Dan. 8:14** The 2300 days reach from 457 BC to 1844 AD, when the heavenly sanctuary would be cleansed from sin, and the judgment hour began.
- 1 John 2:1** Jesus is acting as our advocate in the judgment in heaven right now!
- Heb. 7:25** He is able to save to the uttermost.
- Ecc. 12:13-14** God asks us to keep His commandments, as God will bring every work into judgment, whether it be good or evil.
