Text Guide #15

- Matt. 28:18-20** Christ's commission was to teach and baptize all nations.
- Mark 16:15-16** He that believes *and* is baptized shall be saved.
- John 3:5** We must be born of water (baptized) and the Spirit to be saved.
- Eph. 4:4-5** There is only one method of Bible baptism.
- Rom. 6:3-6** Baptism is symbolic of a death to sin, burial of sins, guilt, and the old life, and resurrection to a new life. We become a new creature in Jesus.
- Matt. 3:13-17** Jesus was baptized by immersion.
- John 3:23** John the Baptist baptized where there was much water.
- Acts 8:36-38** Philip baptized the Ethiopian eunuch by immersion after he taught him.
- Acts 2:37-38** Those who were baptized repented of their sins.
- Acts 2:41, 47** They were gladly baptized, and Christ added them to the church.
- Rom. 6:11** When baptized, we are dead to sin.
- John 1:12-13** When baptized and born again, we receive the Holy Spirit's power to do God's will.
- Acts 19:1-5** Rebaptism is our privilege if we have been baptized in a non-Biblical way, or if we have learned more truth and desire to show our love and loyalty to follow Jesus in all truth.
- 2 Cor. 11:2** Baptism is like a marriage; we pledge to belong to Christ and to love Him no matter what. We grow, and make mistakes, but we grow with Jesus.
- Gal. 3:27** We have put on Christ when baptized, and are now "Christians."
- John 10:14-16** Jesus invites us into the one fold with one Shepherd.
- Acts 22:16** Jesus asks, "Why tarriest thou? ...Be baptized, and wash away thy sins."
