- Matt. 16:18** Jesus said He would build His church.
- Eph. 4:5** There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism.
- 1 Tim. 3:15** Christ's church is to be the pillar and ground of the truth.
- Rev. 12:1** God's church is represented by a virtuous woman dressed in white.
- Rev. 17:1-5** The scarlet woman represents the false church.
- Dan. 8:12** This church cast the truth down to the ground.
- Rev. 17:5** The Bible calls this system 'Babylon'.
- Gen. 11:1-9** Babylon means 'confusion', and represents spiritual confusion.
- Dan. 4:30** Babylon is a man-made system based on human tradition and achievement.
- Ezk. 8:14** Ancestor worship was common in Babylon.
- Ecc. 9:5** The Bible says the dead know not anything. They are asleep.
- Ezk. 8:16** Sun worship enters God's temple.
- Ezk. 20:12, 20** The Sabbath day is God's sign (seal).
- Rev. 17:2** Babylon has made the whole world drunk with her wine (doctrine).
- Rev. 16:13-14** Spiritualism will deceive multitudes in the last days.
- Rev. 13:15; 14:9-10** Virtually the entire world will receive the Mark of the Beast (Sunday sacredness, enforced).
- Rev. 17:5** Babylon's daughters teach her doctrines.
- Rev. 18:1-4** God calls His people to come out of fallen Babylon and into truth.
- Heb. 11:8** When God called Abraham out of Babylon, he obeyed.
- Rev. 14:12** Christ's people love Him, so will keep His commandments, and have the faith of Jesus.
