Matt. 12:30 We're either 100% with Christ, or against Him.
Matt. 12:31-32 The Unpardonable Sin is the sin against the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit Does Three Primary Works

ONE . . .

John 16:13 leads us into all truth, which is:

- **Jesus** (John 14:6)
- **The Word** (John 17:17)
- **The Law** (Ps. 119:142, 151)

2 Th. 2:10-12 If we do not love and follow where the Spirit leads, we cannot be saved.

TWO . . .

John 16:7-8 The Holy Spirit reproves of sin, judgment and righteousness.
Hos. 4:6 If we reject this knowledge, God rejects us.
John 3:19 We are condemned for staying in darkness once the light comes.
John 9:41 When we see the truth and we refuse to obey, that is sin (James 4:17).
1 John 3:4 Sin is the transgression of the law.
Heb. 10:26-27 If we willfully sin after receiving truth, there is no more sacrifice for sin.
Heb. 6:4-6 If the Holy Spirit leads us and we refuse to follow, we begin to commit the unpardonable sin.

THREE . . .

1 Cor. 12:13 The Holy Spirit leads us to baptism into one body of believers.
Eph. 4:4-5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism.
John 10:16 One fold and one shepherd.

A good example of the unpardonable sin is found in Acts 7:51. The Jewish people resisted the Holy Spirit and committed the unpardonable sin. The issue was (v 53) they would not keep God's law! It is the same today. People allow the Holy Spirit to lead them part way, but resist God's law.

Rev. 21:8 At the top of the list of people who will not be saved are the "fearful" and "unbelieving." If we are too afraid to stand up for truth, we cannot enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matt. 7:13-14 The broad, easy way leads to destruction. The narrow way leads to life.
Eph. 4:30 We are sealed by not grieving away God's Spirit as He leads us.
